 - -Our preference would be that young men would wear loose fitting button up shirts. If you want to wear T-shirts, please wear a sweater overtop.
 - -For the young ladies we would prefer loose fitted dresses. We would prefer the tops to be double-covered
 - -We ask that all would apply the principle of modesty of not only covering the body but also concealing the form.
- 5) Please come neatly groomed without styles that draw undue attention.
 - -Please refrain from fashionable hairstyles (applies to all)
 - -For the young ladies we would ask that if your head is not covered that you would pin up your hair.
 - -Please apply the principle of modesty in this area also!
- 6) Please nurture healthy, God-honoring relationships
- 7) We would desire for every student to bring their <u>printed</u> Bible.
 - -If you do not have one, please make it known, and we would be glad to provide one for you.
- 8) We would ask everyone to leave their cell phones at their place of lodging.
 - -If you are driving, we permit you to have your cell phone with you for emergency purposes only. We would ask you to hand in your cell phones upon arrival each day. **Phone service is available at the building **
- 9) Please cultivate an attitude of love and respect for all Bible School staff.
 - -This includes the cooks and janitorial
- 10) Leaving the premises is not permitted without permission from the principal/administrator or matron(s)
 - -Walks are permitted on the property and along the alleyway
- 11) We request that students refrain from all activities that would be a distraction from the purpose and goal of Bible School.
